Lake Panasoffkee: I-75 exit 329. (SR 44 Wildwood) Go west for 2 miles on SR 44. Entrance on south side of SR 44—look for signs. From SR 41 in Inverness—go east on SR 44 for 12-14 miles.

Reminder:

*Be sure to sign in at all parks when you ride.

*Guests riding with Suncoast Trail Riders must sign up with the trail boss before the ride leaves the trail head.

*Effective October 1, 2009. In Florida, all riders under the age of 16 must wear a helmet when riding on any public roads or trails.

*Remember that each rider must carry proof of a current negative Coggins test for your horse with you on the trails. Although we are rarely asked to show one, as responsible horse owners, we should be prepared.
