*We usually have 2 groups at each club ride. Fast group-gaited horse walk, slow group-quarter horse walk. The rides last about 2 ½ hours.

Reminder:

*Be sure to sign in at all parks when you ride.

*Guests riding with Suncoast Trail Riders must sign up with the trail boss before the ride leaves the trail head.

*Effective October 1, 2009. In Florida, all riders under the age of 16 must wear a helmet when riding on any public roads or trails.

***Remember that each rider must carry proof of a current negative Coggins test for your horse with you on the trails. Although we are rarely asked to show one, as responsible horse owners, we should be prepared.**
